
DAILY CLEANING

Cleaning

Use a neutral or slightly alkaline (PH value 7-9) detergent and cold / lukewarm water in a bucket, spray bottle or small low pressure sprayer.

Apply the soap solution and let it work. Stains can be processed with a nylon cloth. Wipe with a twisted hygienic cloth.

Disinfection

In case of good daily cleaning, disinfection of hygiene rooms is not necessary, with the exception of infectious diseases / infections, or in areas where health personnel have defined this as a requirement.

Tip: Always apply detergent where it is most dirty first so that the cleaning agent gets the longest possible time of action.

HOUSECLEANING

Lime, rust, pea

Use an acidic concentrated detergent (pH value 1-5) and cold water in a bucket or low pressure sprayer. Use a viscous detergent that adheres to vertical surfaces.

Apply the detergent (possibly diluted with water) and let the solution work. Process difficult areas with brush or nylon sponge. Rinse with cold water, wipe it out with a wrinkled cloth or chamois leather.

Soap residue, skin fat

Always use an alkaline detergent (PH_care 9-14). Otherwise, do the same as described above.

Remember: On vertical surfaces, detergent are always applied from floor to ceiling, to avoid drying edges.

NOTE: Strong, acidic and alkaline detergent are often irritating or corrosive. Therefore, avoid application equipment that provides spray mist or hot water (forms dimmable). Use prescribed protective equipment.
